Surrendering to God simplifies life. We can sort through issues quickly and wisely when we set our sails toward God. "No good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless" (Ps. 84:11).

Surrendering to God solidifies life. He works mightily on behalf of those who have yielded themselves to him. "Therefore, we will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea" because "He is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in time of trouble" (Ps. 46:1-2).
